Another need we have that is vitally important to the Camp is our scholarship fund. Last summer we used most of what we had and now need to replenish that fund. The scholarship fund allows kids who can't afford the cost of camp to come and experience God's love and grace. We need about \$3,000 to make that fund viable again.

**Faith Like A Mustard Seed**

The first snow of 2012 reminded me of standing at the top of a steep hill on a cold winter day with a couple of feet of snow on the ground. We all had sleds and had made several runs down the hill already. The snow was compacting and the sleds would race down the hill at what seemed to be blinding speed. Each run was better than the last. Someone suggested we add a little spice to the run by adding a ramp to jump over. The problem was that there were trees on the hill side and turning a speeding sled required a deft touch and nerves of steel if you were to avoid serious injury.

Faith in ourselves was probably misplaced, but no serious injuries occurred. Faith like this is misplaced because we really didn't have the skills to avoid the trees, we were simply lucky.

This story helps me remember that misplaced faith can lead to much more than bumps and bruises. The Bible says that misplaced faith leads to eternal destruction. The kind of faith we need is the same faith the blind man had when he heard that Jesus was passing by. He shouted until Jesus heard him and when Jesus asked what he wanted the blind man said, "I want to see." (Mark 10:46-52) Or maybe the kind of faith that allowed the woman with the bleeding sickness to step up and touch Jesus' cloak to be healed. (Matthew 9:20-22)

Trusting in something we can see is no faith at all. Hebrews 11:1 says that faith is "being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see." Put your faith in the only place that you can be certain that it will come true, in Jesus.

Please don't go out and make stupid decisions and get hurt. Go out and make the decision that leads to eternal life, step up and trust Jesus and His life saving blood. Faith out.
